



History of Converging Agendas: Some Key Milestones

- 1998 Six organizations led by NASF sends letter to CEQ and OMB about C&I
- 1999 Roundtable on Sustainable Forests finalizes Charter focusing initially on use of C&I
- 2003 Forest Service completes National Report on Sustainable Forests based upon C&I
- 2005 NASF releases Stewardship Handbook using C&I as framework; and Forest Service revises Stewardship Program Guidelines
- 2008 Discussions underway about integrating C&I related efforts of Roundtables
