

Common Themes/Overlap

All Roundtables Have Indicators Covering:

- Areal extent/amount of resource
- Ecosystem goods and services
- “Importance” of resource
- Recreation
- Riparian “systems” “supporting flora and fauna and related ecosystem processes” “water-related resources such as riparian zones”
- Productivity of “rangelands” “ecosystems” “net sustained yield”

Forest and Rangeland Roundtables Have Indicators Covering:

- Fragmentation
- Soils
- Disturbance
- At-risk species

Gaps

Process

- Lack of a shared or common level of detail or language articulating what is being measured in the indicator name

Content

- Permanent conservation of resources (4-33 Area of rangelands under conservation ownership or control by conservation organizations)
- Carbon storage (5.ab Total forest ecosystem carbon pools and fluxes and total forest product carbon pools and fluxes)
- Birds (Breeding Bird Survey as data source)
- Restoration (4-34 Expenditures (monetary and in-kind) to restoration activities)
- Resilience of resource dependent communities (6.3.c Resilience of forest-dependent communities; 4-43 Sources of income and level of dependence on livestock production for household income; fishing for recreation)
- Sustainable management practices (sustainable agriculture; forestry BMPs 4.2.a; “renewable supply”)
